**TIMES** You should report to the main office located inside the west entrance of the high school at 7:45 am, at which time you will be introduced to your ICBS host. The school day starts at 7:55 am and ends at 2:50 pm. You should arrange to be picked up at the main office at the end of the day.

**LUNCH** You will be given a voucher to use in the cafeteria to purchase lunch. If you have any food allergies, please notify the Admissions Office at least two days prior to your visit.
