Advancement

In conjunction with the start of our 75th anniversary celebration, ICHS leadership began quietly soliciting pledges to help fund the school's emerging facility priorities. These priorities surfaced during the spring and summer through the thoughtful input of well over 500 key stakeholders. Facility improvements include:

- Complete renovation of the three existing science labs to create leading-edge learning facilities.
- Establishment of new athletic fields at Plunkett Field including all-season field turf, new bleachers and press box.
- Renovation of the field house at Plunkett Field.
- Contribution to assist in funding shared campus-wide facility renovations.

Improvements to these facilities will be implemented over time, as pledges are secured.

The **Celebrating Tradition...Building Our Future** leadership is hosting two functions in the months ahead. One function will be held at the end of November and the other in January. These events will allow us to share information on our progress and plans, as well as generate additional enthusiasm and financial support for the projects.

Program Enhancements

In addition to addressing the emerging facility needs, administration has established the first of its *ad hoc* task forces designed to look at program opportunities and challenges.
