- II. Approval of Minutes from February, 2010 meeting
  - a. Discussion of Relay for Life team led by Steve Maloney. Parents Club will make a donation of \$200.

  - a. Total deposits of \$1686.90 (yard signs and play) ; withdrawals of \$1281.09 (play, ring ceremony, misc); ending balance of \$6267.05
  - b. Spring Play: Purchases (\$512.90); Start up money (\$405.00); Deposits \$1636.90; Profit \$719.00

  - a. Spring Play: Ms. Levar was approached by the ICGS Play producers to discuss the lighting situation for the theater production. They are asking the high school for \$10,000 (half of the \$20,000 total). The Parents Club will donate \$2,000 toward the purchase of the lighting system, and will re-look at the possibility of additional donations in the near future.
